TECHNOLOGY GRANTS

We continue to be blessed by our wonderful relationship with Roswell United Methodist Church. Family Promise was just awarded a \$3,000 grant to go towards upgrading our technology in our Career Center where families can research and prepare for employment and begin their search for future housing alongside our case managers.
