Our vision is to live in a world where no child is without a safe place to rest their head at night.



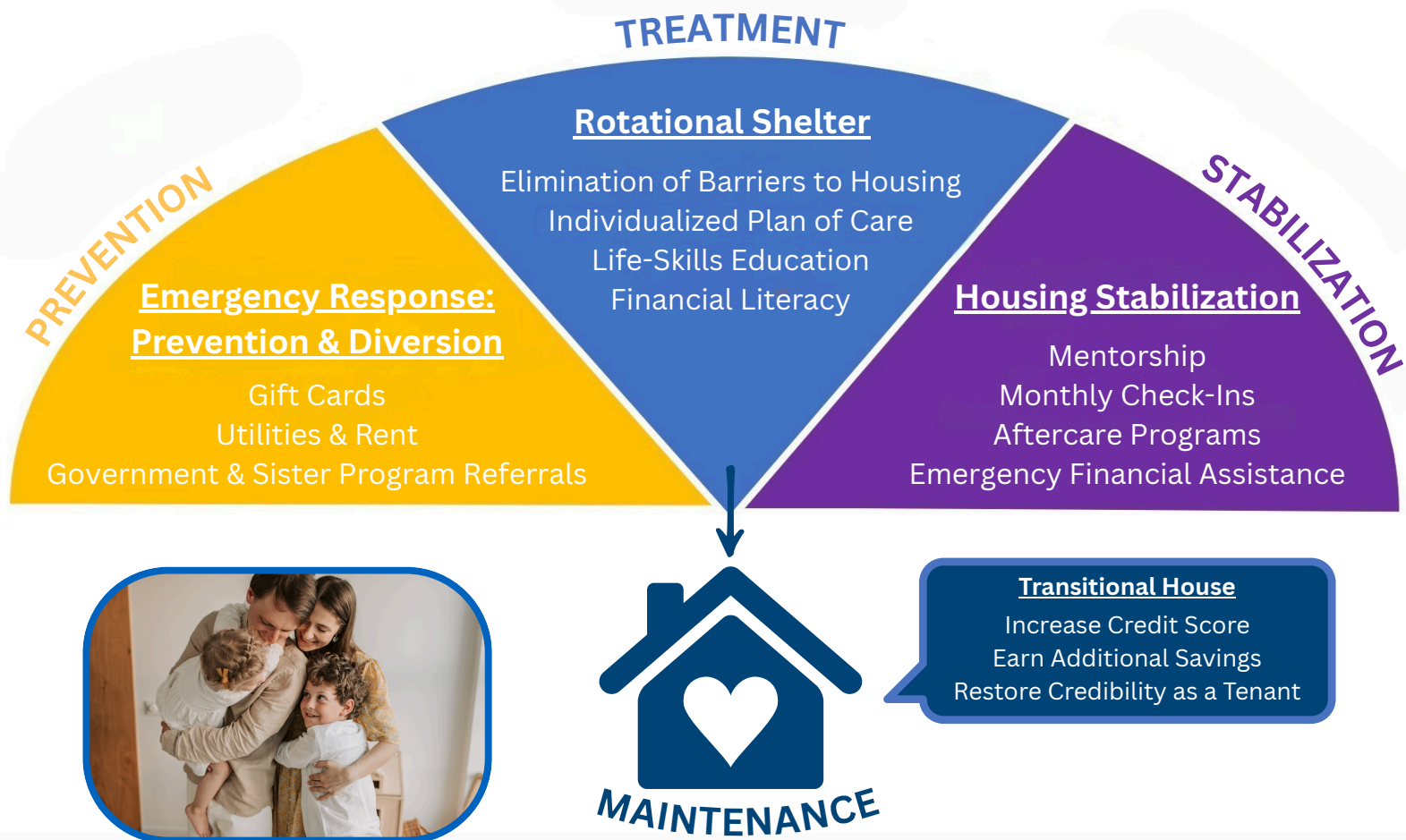

Emergency Response Program

This program prevents homelessness by providing at-risk families with support like gas or food cards, utilities and rent. It also connects families to other programs for help.

Rotational Shelter Program

Family Promise keeps families together, unlike traditional shelters. Our Rotational Shelter Program partners with faith-based organizations, where Host Congregations provide shelter, meals, and hospitality on a rotating basis, and Support Congregations offer extra volunteers.

Housing Stabilization Program

This aftercare program supports families who have transitioned from our Rotational Shelter Program to independent housing. It provides mentoring, monthly case management, and occasional financial assistance to help prevent a return to homelessness.

Transitional House

Partnering with St. David's Episcopal Church, FPNFD is embarking on our first Transitional Living Home. For 6-12 months, two families who have graduated from the Rotational Shelter Program will work & pay rent on a sliding scale.

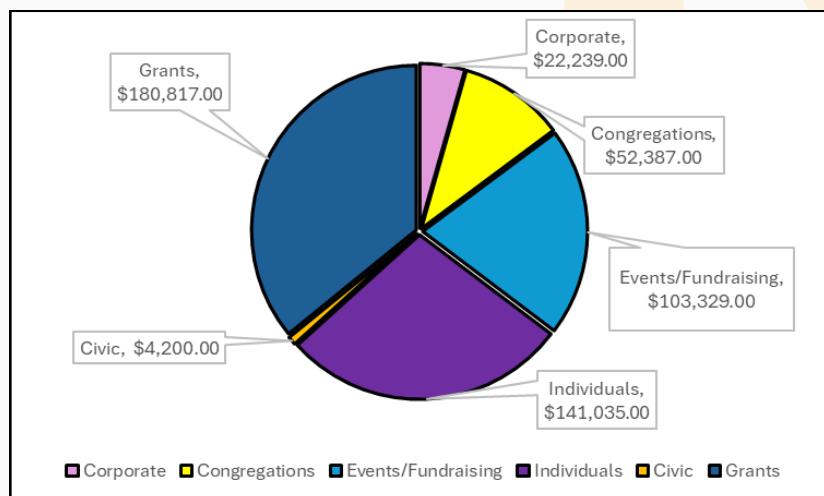
VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES: COME GET INVOLVED!

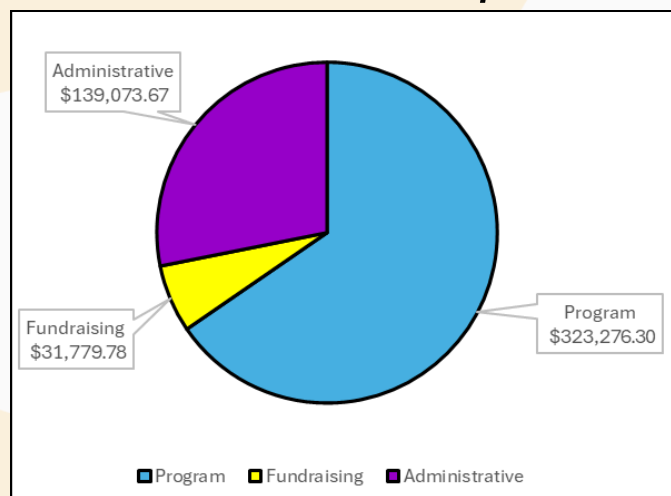
