2023 GRATITUDE REPORT

Homelessness was prevented for **151** individuals

31 individuals had a safe place to sleep while working to regain housing

54 individuals remained stably housed for over 12 months

Housing Stabilization

14 families remained stably housed for 12 months

2 families assisted with an unexpected expense

On August 18, 2023, De'Andre, a father of three, suffered a heart attack. Surgeries were performed to remove the clot, and medical intervention was undertaken to stabilize his cardiac disease, rendering him unable to work for several weeks until cleared by his personal care physician. Although his employer had terminated his position, they were willing to rehire De'Andre, but not until February of 2024.

"Returning to this job will allow me to get things back to financially stable to support all of my living needs for my family. But I needed help with this month's rent to get through until that time. I really appreciate you."

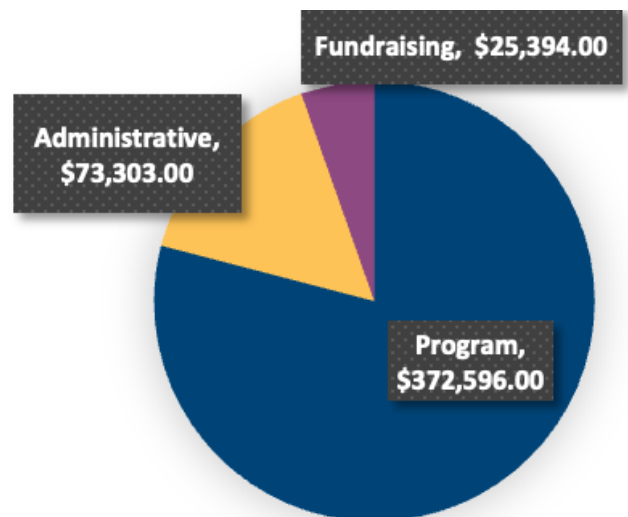
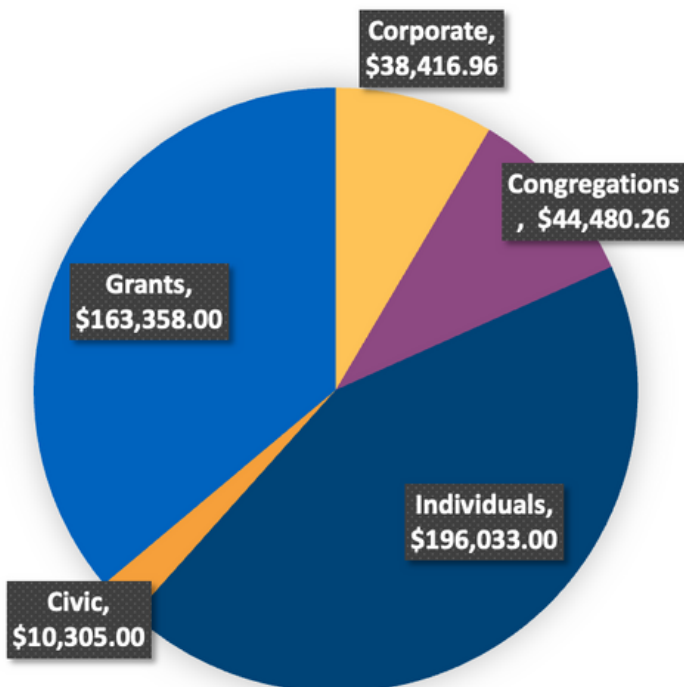
